


ST HUGH'S COLLEGE



How to Get to St Hugh's College



St. Hugh's College is located to the north of central Oxford between Canterbury Road and St Margaret's Road, about 15 minutes' walk from the centre of Oxford.

By car:

Short-term parking (up to 2 hours) is available on both St Margaret's and Canterbury Roads. We have limited free parking onsite that is available by prior agreement with the Conference Office.

Park and Ride services run approximately every 6 minutes from Pear Tree Roundabout (off the A34) to Canterbury Road along the Woodstock Road

By rail:

Oxford Station is to the west of the city centre at the end of Park End Street.

It is about 5 minutes' taxi ride to St Hugh's. Taxis are available at the station.

By coach:

There are regular 24 hour coach services between London and Oxford.

They run approximately every 20 minutes during the day and the journey takes about 90 minutes from Central London to Gloucester Green in Oxford, depending on the traffic.

Coaches to Oxford also run from both Heathrow and Gatwick Airports, as well as other major towns.
