## **INFORMATION SECURITY TRAINING**

This is to remind all staff that they **MUST ANNUALLY** complete the university on line Information Security and Data Privacy Awareness course.

The content of the course has been created in order to help you:

- Understand the importance of protecting data
- Understand data privacy rules
- Know how to safely access and share information
- Know how to keep your information safe in the office, at home, and in public places
- Know how to spot phishing
- Know how to use your own device to work securely
- Know how to report issues

It is hosted on CoSy and there is step by step advice on how to book on a course. To pass the module you need a score of 75 or above. You will be asked to take the module again if you do not pass. Once you've passed you'll receive a confirmation email from the system including a link to download a certificate.
