# BACKING UP YOUR DATA TO THE HFS: THE UNIVERSITY'S BACKUP/ARCHIVE SERVICE

The Hierarchical File Server (HFS) is a university-wide backup service, open to all postgraduates and all staff. This course will give you an introduction to backing up your data to the HFS, using software called Spectrum Protect (formerly Tivoli Storage Manager (TSM)). You will learn about the different types of backup account for which you can register; how to install Spectrum Protect; and how to back up and restore your data.

They do not accept money but instead have a requirements board where things needed are listed. Requirements are many and varied from a digital clock to medications. We decided to pay some of the considerable hospital bill, to do this we went to the local hospital.




# 2nd donation.

Pingalwara (literally a home of the cripple) this organisation's base is in Amritsar very close to the Golden Temple, it was set up in 1947 by Bhagat Puran Singh. The basic tenant of this organisation is Moral Responsibility. Every sick person who is physically unfit to earn his livelihood has the divine right to be looked after through men and organisations working in the field of social service and charity.

The unit we visited housed 153 women young and old with diabetes and or mental health problems. There were several units throughout the city, including one for children (newborn babies are often left within the Golden Temple) here the children are cared for and educated.

After visiting this unit we had to scarily cross a very busy indian road to make our Donation.



# **3rd donation**

Unfortunately I had come back to UK before this donation was made, I can tell you it went to a Physiotherapy Clinic in Ludihana (Hardeep was a physio assistant when she lived in India).
