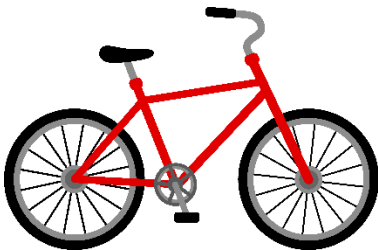

BIKE SECURITY



There have been a few cases recently where bikes have been stolen around the Churchill campus, from both University and NHS staff. It would be hugely beneficial for us to have proper bike storage but, unfortunately, this isn't possible as the NHS won't pay for this. For those with bikes, what I would suggest is the following:

Use the outside bike storage by the POD; it's not covered but you can lock your bike to a solid piece of metal.

Use a solid D-lock, not a cable one; Security Services offer high-quality ones for £18:

Put your bike on BikeRegister; if your bike does get stolen then you have a higher chance of getting it back: <https://www.bikeregister.com/>
