The DTU is a UKCRC registered clinical trials unit, specialising in performing national and multinational clinical trials related to the treatment and management of cardiometabolic and related disorders.

Reporting to the DTU's Head of Clinical Research, you will oversee clinical trial set up and delivery ensuring that all activities meet quality and regulatory requirements within the agreed timelines and budget. You will work closely with multiple internal and external collaborators and industry sponsors to ensure successful delivery of trials. The post holder will be responsible for the line management of the current Clinical Trial Manager, with a view to managing additional staff in the future.


Candidates should have significant clinical trial and project management experience with a current working knowledge of GCP, GDPR, Research Governance and other key regulatory and ethical frameworks.
