## Overview

Research Services and Research Accounts work in partnership with academic divisions, departments, research facilitators, University Administration and Services (UAS) and Oxford University Innovation Ltd to provide comprehensive support to researchers throughout the research lifecycle.

They run the Research Support website which contains a wealth of information about all aspects of research funding: finding funding, costing grant applications, applying for funding, managing awards, clinical trials & research governance, research integrity & ethics, and research contracts.

## Support within RDM

If you are thinking of applying for research funding, including outline/preliminary applications and proposals made by external collaborators with an Oxford component, please discuss your plans with your local grants administration team *at an early stage* (a minimum of 2 weeks before the funders deadline, but preferably much earlier). Most proposals require an internal costing using the University's

costing and pricing tool X5 and your local grants team can provide this and other support.

Ruth provides advice and support to researchers transitioning to independence; co-ordinates fellowship applications submitted from RDM; provides strategic research support, co-ordination and guidance to the Head of Department and Principal Investigators; assists in the development of major scientific initiatives; and co-ordinates scientific bids across RDM Divisions.

RDM coordinates all applications for fellowships being submitted from the Department. Anyone wishing to apply for a Fellowship must inform Ruth McCaffrey as early as possible in the process so that suitable fellowship schemes can be identified and advice, guidance and support can be provided throughout the application process. your local admin team needs to approve your application and then research services require at least **five working days** to review and approve your application, in advance of the sponsor deadline. It is important to plan ahead! Some funding calls require RDM to prioritise and rank bids in advance of submission so RDM sets an earlier internal deadline.

Some applications require a letter of support from the Head of Department or a commitment of resources. These requests should be sent to Ruth McCaffrey well in advance of any internal funding deadlines.

## Finding Funding

### The RDM Funding Opportunities Bulletin

is produced every two months and contains information on upcoming internal and external funding opportunities. All RDM internal funding deadlines are announced via this bulletin. ### The RDM Funding Database

### ResearchProfessional.com

is an online research funding opportunities database and alerting service that the University subscribes to. All members of the University can create a free account and use the service to find research funding in any discipline. You can set up specific searches to find funding relevant to your interests/career stage and get weekly email alerts.
