### **SYMPLECTIC UPGRADE**

On Tuesday 10 July between 09:00 and 13;)) Symplectic Elements (SE) will be upgraded. The upgrade will introduce **automatic claiming of publications based on ORCID ID** and other identifiers. . So if you have an ORCID ID and it's linked to your Symplectic Account (see the <u>user guide</u>), and you use your ORCID ID in all your publications, then Symplectic will automatically claim the publication as yours, without manual intervention
